At Arca Continental, we operate a sustainable business model that is integrated into the thinking and actions of those who collaborate within the organization, and developed jointly with suppliers and customers throughout the value chain.

It is a key component for sustainable growth, operational excellence, environmental protection, and the overall development of the community, enclosed by an ethical, transparent, and responsible framework, driven from within our corporate culture and corporate governance.

With the issuance of our first green bond in 2021, we reiterate our commitment and leadership towards environmental initiatives, while contributing significantly to meeting the Sustainable Development Objectives of the United Nations.

In 2022 we allocated a total of Ps. 2,114.3 million towards projects corresponding to four of the categories of our Framework: Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency, Sustainable Water and Waste Water Management, and Eco-efficient and/or Circular Economy Adapted Products, Production Technologies and Processes.

Investments spanned projects in all five countries in which we operate.

As of the date of this report, we have allocated 100% of the proceeds obtained.





PACKAGING AND WASTE

At a time of disruptions in the global supply chain, which brought challenges in our purchase of raw materials for production, we maintained a solid relationship based on trust with our suppliers and we developed innovative solutions to manage inventories, making us able to sustain the continuity of our operations and the achievement of our goals.

We reached a global average of 23.6% RPET + BIOPET contained in our packages, thus avoiding the usage of over 42 thousand tons of virgin resin thanks to recycling, lightening, and innovation projects.

PACKAGING (%)











WATER FOOTPRINT
